

**REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS  
NEW YORK HIDEYO NOGUCHI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 2018**

This scholarship is designed to support young scientists from Japan to pursue research career in the US. The New York Hideyo Noguchi Memorial Society, Inc. (HNMS) was established in 2013 with the mission and goals: 1) to ensure the preservation and upkeep of Dr. Hideyo Noguchi's graveyard and its monument. 2) to inspire and support the Japanese children and students who aspire to study medicine in the United States. 3) to pass on Dr. Hideyo Noguchi's achievements in medicine and his inspiration to future generations. 4) to strengthen cultural ties and connections between the United States and Japan. HNMS is dedicated to awarding a scholarship award each year to a young scientist in life science that upholds the principle that guided Dr. Hideo Noguchi- "Through devotion to science, he lived and died for humanity" HNMS is seeking outstanding applicants who are constant with its mission and goals. Each application should be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a mentor. The scholarship is \$2,000. The award will be announced on May 21, 2108 at the Woodlawn Cemetery. If you receive an award, you will be expected to attend the award ceremony and submit an annual progress report.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- 1) The applicant must be a graduate student who is seeking MD and/or PhD degrees or non-faculty fellow with an MD and/or PhD degree(s).
- 2) The applicant must have been engaged in life science research.
- 3) The applicant must have prior higher education or life science training in Japan.
- 4) The applicant must be admitted to a graduate school or hired in an academic institution in the US.

- 1) Application form with applicant's name, academic position, mailing address, telephone and e-mail address
- 2) NIH biosketch
- 3) Outline of applicant's research project stating the broad, long-term objectives and specific aims. English is preferred for administrative purposes.
- 4) Personal statement. English is preferred for administrative purposes.
- 5) Letter of recommendation from applicant mentor in the US
