For Annual Dinner Benefactors:

- (1) If as a Diamond, Platinum, Gold or Silver Benefactor, you wish to attend the dinner, we are pleased to welcome ten(10) persons as our guests for the dinner table. In this case, the non-deductible amount will be \$180. per person based on the regular single ticket price for \$400 per person for the dinner or 45% of a single dinner ticket. It will be \$1,800. in total per table. Therefore, you may deduct as a charitable contribution as follows:
 - 1) Diamond: You may deduct \$8,200. in total after subtracting \$1,800 from \$10,000.
 - 2) Platinum: You may deduct \$6,200. in total after subtracting \$1,800 from \$8,000.
 - 3) Gold: You may deduct \$4,200 in total after subtracting \$1,800 from \$6,000.
 - 4) Silver: You may deduct \$2,200 in total after subtracting \$1,800 from \$4000.
- (2) If you purchase Bronze Level: we are pleased to welcome five (5) persons as our guests for the dinner table. In this case, your total non-deductible amount will be \$900 (\$180 x 5). Therefore, you may deduct \$1,100 after subtracting \$900. from \$2,000.
- (3) If you will not attend the dinner, no goods or service will be provided in exchange of your contribution. Therefore, you may deduct 100% of the amount a charitable contribution.

JMSA is a tax-exempt, Non-Profit Organization (NPO) and a public charity. Therefore, all donations are tax-deductible and regular priced tickets to fundraiser dinners are 45% tax deductible. The Japanese Medical Society of America, Inc. (JMSA) is a tax-exempt organization with Federal Tax ID#23-7383500.
